The "appy" babies have started to arrive and I hope they're full of spots. Congratulations to all of you with new arrivals.

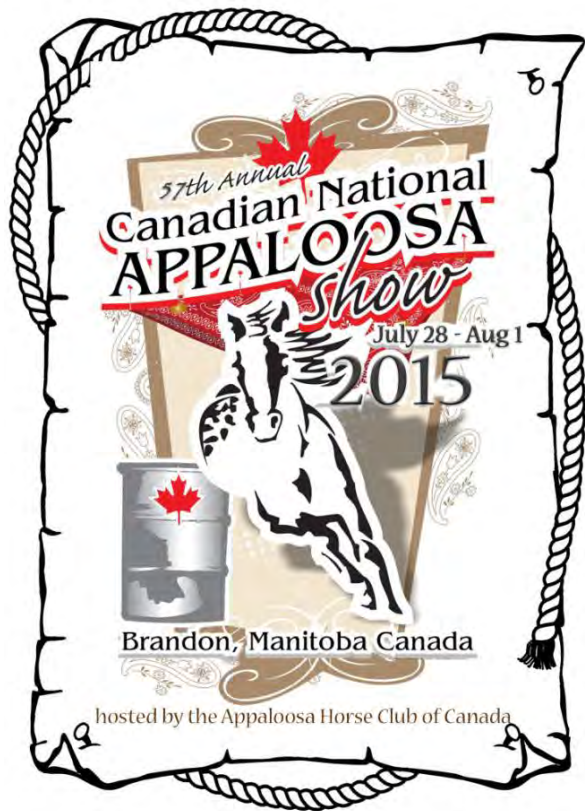

That's it for now. Our next meeting is Tuesday April 28 at Pat's house. Contact her for directions.

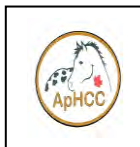
ApHCC Booth Report

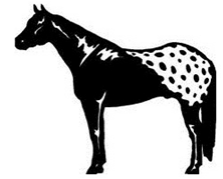
